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## WALK, HIKE, TREK AND RAMBLE WITH PARKDEAN

It even tells you the type of area the route takes you – coastal, countryside, crags or fells! If you prefer a five minute stroll to an hour long trek, just look at the distance and duration keys next to the route which tell you how long your walk should take you.

Some of Parkdean's walk route recommendations:

### Devon

Little Dartmouth and Dartmouth Castle: While staying at one of Parkdean's Devon holiday parks take your family on a hike around the local area, taking in the natural beauty of Dartmouth National Park. This short route starts at the National Park car park at Redlap and takes you along a coastal path where you can take in the stunning views and takes you right up to Dartmouth Castle where your family can learn about the history and heritage of the local area. Heading back over the bridleways, this four mile trek crosses the River Dart before taking you back to where you started.

Allow an hour for this easy/ moderate path but beware of the uneven paths and mud in wet weather – definitely one to take your wellies on!

Escape to Parkdean's Challaborough Bay or Torquay holiday parks located near to the Dartmouth National Park. Escape with the family on a three night short break commencing 9 July to Torquay Holiday Park from only £228 or a 4 night mid week stay at Challaborough Bay Holiday Park commencing 19 July from only £330!

### Cornwall

Holywell and Kelsey Head: While staying at one of Parkdean's eight Cornish holiday parks take advantage of the fantastic scenery and let your legs take you places that your car can't! The Holywell and Kelsey Head is classified as a difficult route so don your walking boots and head to Parkdean's Holywell Holiday Park located near Newquay. The five mile trek allows you to take in the sights of the

Holywell coastlines and Kelsey Head while also giving you an opportunity to look for maritime animals and Cubert Common. Parkdean holidaymakers have reviewed the route giving it 5 out of 5 stars, Mr D Allen from Newcastle comments, *'Fantastic track to see the surrounding area and made the most of the breathtaking scenery. Takes you from Holywell's car park and is circular no need to drive anywhere, will definitely be going on the route next visit!'*

Allow two hours for this steep climb through the sand dunes and keep a look out for the seals!
